

2018 PRIDE VMC Veterinary Student Leadership Grant Application

PRIDE Veterinary Medical Community (formerly LGVMA), thanks to the generosity of VCA, Zoetis and Hill's Pet Nutrition, is proud to again offer leadership grants to veterinary students and Broad Spectrum veterinary student chapters, each in an amount not to exceed \$500.00 for individuals and \$1000.00 for chapters, for leadership activities and/or programs that are aligned with PRIDE VMC's organizational mission and vision.

Mission: PRIDE VMC is the oldest professional organization that fosters acceptance, inclusivity and leadership for veterinarians, veterinary technicians, and veterinary students, of all sexual orientations and gender identities, and their allies, through community development, professional advocacy, and personal empowerment.

Vision: Our vision is a veterinary profession in which we all live to our full potential, both personally and professionally, conduct our lives openly and with integrity, and freely share our experience and wisdom for the betterment of and care of ourselves, our profession, our clients and all animals.

Specifically, grant requests will be accepted and considered for proposals in the following areas:

1. Veterinary students, or groups of students, who wish to develop and implement programs within the veterinary community or college that are aligned with PRIDE VMC's mission and vision.* (up to \$1000)

*e.g., starting a new Broad Spectrum student chapter at your school, lecture program, fundraiser, community outreach, etc. or to enhance your current campus program.

2. Veterinary students who seek assistance to participate in leadership development programs/conferences/externships that are in aligned with PRIDE VMC's mission and vision. Must indicate how this will empower leadership development and follow up in your career or schooling.** (up to \$500)

** travel, lodging, registration for a conference or event

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested individuals or groups should submit a one-page grant proposal via our website at <http://pridevmc.org/grants/> or by emailing info@pridevmc.org. This should include the following:

1. A brief personal biography (for all applicants) and individual or group photo
2. An overview of your leadership grant request and how it meets our Mission and Vision.
3. Brief itemized budget for this grant or program amount being requested not to exceed \$500 individual/\$1000 chapters. (Project can be larger, if other funding sources are identified.)
4. An outcome statement describing short and long term goals
5. Applicant must be a paid PRIDE VMC member at the time of submission. Member application online at <http://pridevmc.org> and PRIDE VMC membership is open to everyone
6. Final written report post-event required for submission to be posted on our website.
7. All applicants must include a mailing address for disbursement of the grant award.
